Evening Ringing at St. Swithun, Leonard Stanley (6) 18:30-20:00 (Again, please park considerately on the roads around the church)


Evening Ringing at St. Laurence, Stroud (10) 18:30-20:00

Please enter via the church nave, through the South porch, not the usual tower door.


